

Regulations of the SAINT DANCE online store

§1

Preliminary Provisions

1. The Saint Dance online store, available at www.saintdance.pl, is run by Julia Nowak, running a business under the name Julia Nowak Saint Dance, entered into the Central Register and Information on Economic Activity NIP 6322028616, REGON 389103939
2. These regulations are addressed to all users of the store, also known as customers. It defines the rules for using the online store. Rules and procedure for concluding Sales Agreements with the Customer remotely via the Store.

§2

Definitions

1. Consumer - a natural person concluding a contract with the Seller within the Store, the subject of which is not directly related to his business or professional activity.
2. Seller - a natural person running a business under the name Julia Nowak Saint Dance, entered into the Central Register and Information on Economic Activity (CEIDG) kept by the minister responsible for economy, NIP 6322028616, REGON 389103939
3. Customer - a natural person having full legal capacity, a natural person who is a Consumer, a legal person or an organizational unit without legal personality, to which the Act grants legal capacity, which concludes a Distance Selling Agreement with the seller.
4. Distance contract - contract concluded with the Customer in framework an organized system for concluding distance contracts (as part of the Store), without the simultaneous physical presence of the parties, with the sole use of one or more means of distance communication until the conclusion of the contract inclusive.
5. Account - the customer's account in the Store, data is collected in it provided by the Customer and information about the Orders placed by him in the Store.
6. Registration form - a form available in the Store, to create an account
7. Order form - an interactive form available in the Store that allows you to place an Order, in particular by adding Products to the Basket and specifying the terms of the Sales Agreement, including the method of delivery and payment.

§4

General information

1. The Seller, to the fullest extent permitted by law, is not responsible for disruptions, including interruptions in the functioning of the Store, caused by force majeure, unauthorized actions of third parties or incompatibility of the Online Store with the Customer's technical infrastructure.
2. Browsing the Store's assortment does not require creating an Account. Placing orders by the Customer for Products in the Store's assortment is possible by providing the necessary personal and address data enabling the execution of the Order without creating an Account.
3. The final (final) amount to be paid by the Customer consists of the price for the Product and the cost of delivery (including charges for transport, delivery and postal services), about which the Customer is informed on the Store's website when placing the Order, including at the time of expressing the will to be bound by the Sales Agreement.

4. In the case of an Agreement covering subscription or provision of services for an indefinite period, the final price is the total price covering all payments for the settlement period.
5. The Seller reserves the right to implement changes in product prices on an ongoing basis. This right does not affect orders placed before the implementation of the price change.

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Rules for placing an Order

Orders for products available in the Online Store can be placed seven days a week, twenty-four hours a day. To make an order:

1. log in to the Store (optional)
2. select the Product being the subject of the Order, and then click the "Add to cart"
3. If the option of placing an Order without registration has been selected - fill in the Order Form by entering the details of the recipient of the Order and the address to which the delivery is to be made product, select the type of shipment (delivery method Product), payment method and enter invoice details, if any other than the details of the recipient of the Order
4. click the "Order and pay" button
5. choose one of the available payment methods and depending on method of payment, pay for the order within the specified period.

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Delivery and payment methods offered

1. The customer can use the following delivery or collection methods of the ordered Product:
 - a. Postage
 - b. Courier delivery
2. The customer may use the following payment methods:
 - a. Payment by bank transfer to the Seller's account
 - b. Electronic Payments
 - c. Payment by credit card.

§7

Execution of the sales contract

1. The conclusion of the Sales Agreement between the Customer and the Seller takes place after the Customer has placed an Order using the Order Form in the Online Store
2. After placing the Order, the Seller confirms its receipt and at the same time accepts the Order to implementation. Confirmation of receipt of the Order and its acceptance for implementation takes place by sending the appropriate e-mail to the Customer by the Seller to the Customer's e-mail address provided when placing the Order, which contains at least the Seller's statement on receipt of the Order and its acceptance for implementation and confirmation of the conclusion of the Sales Agreement. Upon receipt of the above e-mail by the Customer, the Sales Agreement is concluded between the Customer and the Seller.
3. If the Customer chooses:
 - a. payment by bank transfer, electronic payment or payment by credit card, the Customer is obliged to make the payment within 4 calendar days from the date of conclusion of the Agreement Sales - otherwise the order will be canceled.
4. If you order Products with different dates delivery, the delivery date is the longest given date.
5. The beginning of the period of delivery of the Product to the Customer is counted as follows: From the moment the transfer is credited to the seller's bank account.
6. Orders are processed within 1-6 working days after dispatch, which will take place on the same or next day as the transaction is booked.
7. Delivery of the Product to the Customer is payable, unless the Agreement Sales states otherwise. Product delivery costs (including charges for transport, delivery and postal services) are indicated to the Customer on the Online Store website in the "Delivery costs" tab

and when placing the Order, including when the Customer expresses his will to be bound by Sales agreement.

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Withdrawal from the contract

1. The consumer may withdraw from the Sales Agreement within 14 days without giving any reason.
2. The period specified in par. 1 begins with the delivery of the Product to the Consumer or a person indicated by him other than the carrier.
3. In the case of an Agreement that includes many Products that are delivered separately, in batches or in parts, the date indicated in par. 1 runs from the delivery of the last item, batch or part.
4. The consumer may withdraw from the Agreement by submitting to the Seller declaration of withdrawal from the Agreement. To meet the deadline for withdrawing from the Agreement, it is enough for the Consumer to send a statement before the expiry of this period. The statement should be sent to the e-mail address of the Online Store: saintdance@op.pl
5. In the event of withdrawal from the contract, the Seller will reimburse the Customer for the costs incurred, with the exception of shipping costs incurred by the Customer, immediately, within 14 days from the date of receipt of information on withdrawal from the contract. The refund is made in the same way the payment was received.
6. The seller reserves the right to withhold the return until receipt of the goods.
7. The goods should be returned to the Seller within 7 days from the date of withdrawal from the contract. The consumer is obliged to send the return shipment to the following address: Street Kryszłowa 8A, 43-600 Jaworzno, Poland
8. The consumer covers all direct costs of returning the item (e.g. costs of packaging, security, shipping)

§ 11

Responsibility for defects

1. The Seller is obliged to provide the Customer with goods free from defects.
2. Complaints should be sent to the Seller's e-mail address: saintdance@op.pl
3. The Seller undertakes to consider the complaint within 14 days from the date of receipt of the package containing the Product under complaint.

§ 12

Personal data in the Online Store

1. administrator of personal data of customers of our online store is the seller
2. The seller undertakes to process personal data

4. collected via the website in accordance with this Privacy Policy and the provisions contained in the Act on Personal Data Protection of September 29, 1997. (Dz. U. z 2002r. Nr 101, poz. 926) PL
5. Customers' personal data collected by the administrator via the Online Store are collected in order to implement the Sales Agreement, and if the Customer agrees - also for marketing purposes.
6. Recipients of personal data of the Online Store Customers may be:
 - a. In the case of a Customer who uses the Online Store with the method of delivery by post or courier, the Administrator provides the Customer's collected personal data selected carrier or executing agent shipments at the request of the Administrator.
 - b. In the case of a Customer who uses the Online Store with method of electronic payment or payment card, the Administrator provides the collected personal data of the Customer to the selected entity servicing the above payments in the Online Store.

7. The customer has the right to access their data and their data correcting.
8. Providing personal data is voluntary, but not providing the personal data indicated in the Regulations necessary to conclude the Sales Agreement results in the inability to do so conclusion of this agreement.

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Final Provisions

1. In matters not covered by these Regulations, generally applicable provisions of Polish law shall apply, in particular: the Civil Code, the Act on consumer rights and other specific laws applicable to the operation and functioning of the Store.
2. Photographs of the Products and information about the Products placed on the Store's website are protected by copyright. It is forbidden to copy and distribute them without the Seller's consent.
3. In the event of a possible dispute with the Buyer, the competent court will be the court competent for the seat of the Seller.
4. These regulations come into force on September 1, 2021.
